INTRODUCTION

▶ Internationalization is today one of the essential requirements in the strategy for the improvement of educational institutions, due to the contribution they make both from the point of view of knowledge, good practices, as well as the resources that are shared to raise the quality of higher education.

► The university as an institution, in order to achieve its maximum development and its essence of universality, has to be able to insert itself into the process of internationalization of higher education, as an intrinsic part of the cultural, scientific and academic globalization that takes place objectively on a global scale.

- The internationalization of higher education occurs at three major levels: on a global scale, at the level of each country and within each institution.
- ► The fundamental reasons that determine the internationalization of higher education can be political, economic, socio-cultural and academic.

- It must be a transversal process that involves the entire university community, integrating the international and intercultural dimension into the substantive functions of higher education.
- ► Its objective is to raise the academic and scientific quality of universities.

- In particular, Goal 4 on Quality Education states with regard to higher education: "to ensure equal access for all men and women to quality technical, vocational and higher education, including university education" and to "significantly increase the supply of qualified teachers, including through INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION for teacher training in developing countries; especially the least developed countries and small island developing States"


















INTERNATIONALIZATION INDICATORS


