OUR TEACHING & LEARNING PHILOSOPHY

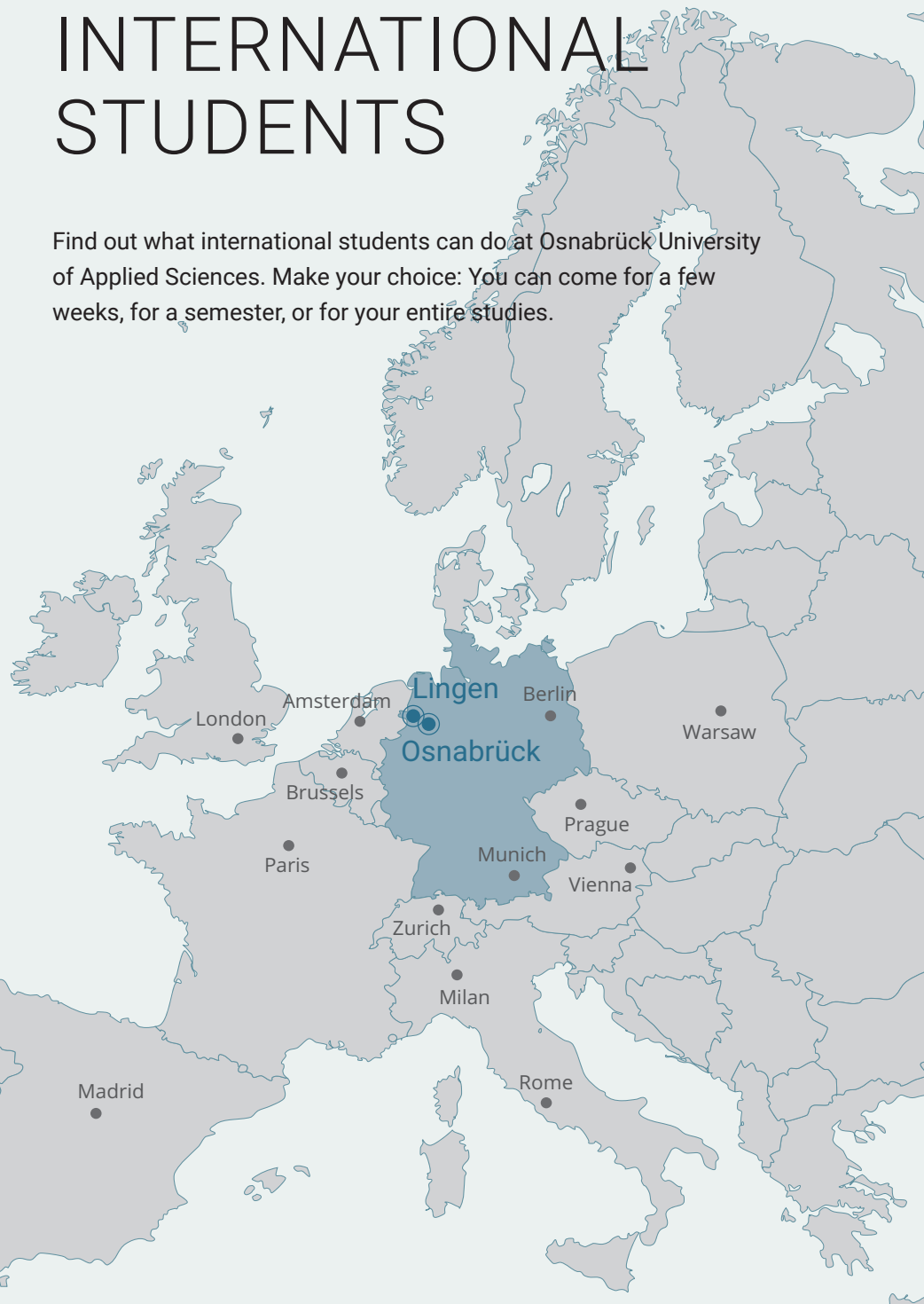

Summer and Winter Activities

Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences offers summer and winter courses to both international and domestic students. Most of these courses take place during the semester breaks. They can be taken for credit and transferred to your home university. All summer and winter courses consist of classwork in combination with field trips, as well as social activities (e.g. German cooking, movie nights, sports).

International Summer University (ISU)

ISU participants can choose from a variety of topics ranging from international business management to physiotherapy and health care management.

Their individual choice will be combined with classes on Germany in Europe, an introduction to German language as well as study trips, company visits and a recreational program. The classes are taught by an international team of professors and lecturers, and thus represent a truly international experience for all students enrolled in the program.

International Summer and Winter Language Courses

The intensive German language courses take place in August/September and in February prior to each of the two semesters that form the academic year. The three to four week programs offer German language instruction at different levels from the absolute beginners to near native competence.

Language classes are combined with a cultural program so that the students will explore not only the university but also the city and its region as well as other interesting places in Germany - a study trip to Berlin is also always part of the program.

International Summer Lab (ISL)

The International Summer Lab is run in cooperation with the renowned German Institute of Food Technologies and attracts students who are interested in improving their knowledge and expertise in food processing and food technologies. During ISL they learn from valuable expert insights into the latest developments in food engineering and food innovation and get hands on experience in special food processing techniques using state of the art equipment.

Summer University Lingen (SUL): Management in a Global Environment

This two-week program at our campus in the city of Lingen draws on the close linkages between the university and the local industry. Many companies are family-run and have deep roots in the region while operating internationally and globally at the same time. SUL invites international and German students to analyze the factors for success by comparing theory based company concepts in e.g. marketing, logistics, and HR management with real life practices in these companies.

International Study Program: Sustainability and Innovation in Engineering and Planning – Key Technologies and their impact on Environment and Society

The six-week International Study Program enables students to enhance their knowledge in engineering, life sciences and planning processes. Exercises, hand-on lab work, company visits and field trips complement the course work. The content always reflects up-to-date topics (e.g. renewable energies, e-mobility, postindustrial development, visualization techniques). The courses are combined with classes on Germany in Europe (culture, history and 'survival German' language classes) as well as study trips, social events and get-togethers with other students.

International Summer University Landscaping Industries

Quality in landscape construction – that is the main topic of the three-week program. It consists of a one-week field trip to historical European cities (e.g. Munich, Salzburg, Vienna) followed by two weeks of lectures and project work in Osnabrück. Students will work on a draft provided by a recognized landscape architecture office and develop a technical solution including construction documentation up to the preparation of the bidding procedure.

LEARNING GERMAN

At Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences, most study programs are taught in German. Therefore, one admission requirement for international degree-seeking students is a German language certificate at C1 (CEF) level. In order to prepare prospective students who lack just this admission requirement, we offer a 5-months' study preparation program that consists of German language instruction, intercultural competence and academic writing.

As a certified telc-Center, we offer telc examinations to external candidates. Of course, there are also preparatory classes that will help you understand the testing format and how you can prepare for the exam.

LIVING IN THE NORTHWEST OF GERMANY: A PERFECT BALANCE

Osnabrück

In 1648, the „Westphalian Peace“ was signed in Osnabrück, ending the War of 30 Years. This treaty was the first step towards a system of international law, and contributes, until today, to a peaceful and prosperous Europe. Since then, Osnabrück has been named the „City of Peace“.

In 2009, Osnabrück was voted the German city with the happiest people. What makes living in Osnabrück so special? Is it the fact that it is the only big city in Germany that is located within the boundaries of a National Park? Is it the rich cultural life? The many green spots? The relatively low cost of living? The beautiful old town? The cozy atmosphere? At a glance: Osnabrück has 170,000 inhabitants and draws on a catchment area of approximately 550,000 people. The unemployment rate in this region is very low at 4.4 per cent.

Living in Osnabrück is very safe. Common sense and good judgment should never be turned off, but it is possible to walk the streets during the day and at night without fear.

Lingen

Looking back on more than 1,000 years of history, Lingen has many stories to tell. Nowadays, 56,000 inhabitants live in Lingen's safe and family-friendly neighborhoods and work in nearby businesses, many of which deserve to be labeled "hidden champions". Lingen has a rich cultural life, and both our students and staff are very active not only in participating in, but also in shaping many activities. Studying in Lingen means becoming a part of the community, both on and off campus.

MONEY MATTERS: CAN I AFFORD OSNABRÜCK AND LINGEN?

Studying in Germany combines two exceptional benefits: A high quality education and a low price. Throughout Germany higher education is almost entirely financed by the tax payer so there are no tuition fees for the individual student.

The cost of living in Osnabrück is low in comparison with most other German cities. In addition, university students get a lot of special deals resulting in lower prices, including the semester ticket for public transportation around the clock and reduced meal prices at the student restaurant.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR VISITING PROFESSORS

Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences believes that exposing students to the teaching methods of international visiting professors improves the quality of the student experience. Therefore, we integrate international colleagues from our partner universities into our teaching and learning processes.

Block/Project Weeks

Almost all curricula contain student projects and other practice-oriented elements (e.g. case studies). In most faculties, these have been condensed into block or project weeks. During these project or block weeks, regular classes are paused, and all students and professors work on projects together. This is an excellent opportunity for visiting professors to offer a one-week intensive program at Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences, and get to know students and colleagues.



WHAT DO INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS SAY ABOUT OSNABRÜCK UAS?

In a recent survey, international students (both degree-seeking and exchange) expressed a very high satisfaction with their experience at Osnabrück UAS. Here are some of the results (International Student Barometer 2016):

- 90 per cent would recommend the university to other international students
- 96.6 per cent say they get learning support when they need it
- 95 per cent stated they were satisfied or very satisfied with the overall support services (international, IT, library, tutors, buddies, housing, etc.) at the university
- 88.6 per cent indicate that they were able to make friends from Germany – this is the best result in Europe and the second best result worldwide in this category
